14. Certain piece of freehold land, being Erf 14, Matjiesfontein, in the Division of Laingsburg, and measuring five decimal one two eight nine (5,128 9) hectares.

*Historical and architectural interest*

The historic Matjiesfontein Village was built between 1895 and 1907 by Mr J. Logan. It was developed as a spa and as such it became the meeting place of historical figures like Cecil Rhodes and Olive Schreiner. During the Anglo-Boer War it served as the headquarters of the supreme command of the British forces in the Cape.

The buildings of this unspoilt Victorian village form a unique whole and mirror the architecture of their era.
