**DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE HOPE
CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH AND PARSONAGE
THEREON, SITUATED ON THE CNR. OF PAULET
AND BEAUFORT STREETS, SOMERSET EAST**

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pierre Cronjé, Deputy Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the Hope Congregational Church and Parsonage thereon, situated on the cnr. of Paulet and Beaufort Streets, Somerset East, to be a national monument.

Description

The property inclusive of the Hope Congregational Church as well as the Parsonage thereon, situate on certain piece of land, being Lot 82 (now known as Erf 20), in the Municipality and Division of Somerset East, in extent six thousand one hundred and sixty-seven (6 167) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 2005/1922, dated 13 March 1922.

Historical and architectural interest

The property on which this church complex is situated was bequeathed to the London Missionary Society in 1842 by Mrs Dorothy Edwards, widow of the Rev. John Evans of Cradock. The parsonage, which was built in the Victorian style, dates from the period 1825-1830. The Neo-Gothic church was erected in 1844. 10/2/1215.

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Oorlogsgrafte en Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Pierre Cronjé, Adjunk-minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby die eiendom met die Hope Kongregasionalistiese Kerkgebou en pastorie daarop, geleë op die hoek van Paulet- en Beaufortstraat, Somerset-Oos, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

Beskrywing

Die eiendom, met inbegrip van die Hope Kongregasionalistiese Kerkgebou en pastorie daarop, geleë op sekere stuk grond, synde Perseel 82 (nou bekend as Erf 20), in die munisipaliteit en afdeling Somerset-Oos, groot sesduisend eenhonderd sewe-en-sestig (6 167) vierkante meter.

Historiese en argitektoniese belang

Die eiendom waarop hierdie kerkkompleks geleë is, is in 1842 aan die Londense Sendinggenootskap bemaak deur mev. Dorothy Edwards, weduwee van eerw. John Evans van Cradock. Die pastorie wat in die Victoriaanse styl gebou is dateer uit die tydperk 1825-1830. Die Neo-Gotiese kerk is in 1844 opgerig. 10/2/1215.
