## No. 2486 17 December 1976 DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the historic Millwood House, at present situate on the Remainder of Erf 1098, Knysna, to be a national monument.

## Description

The building known as Millwood House, at present situate on a certain piece of land in the Municipality and Division of Knysna, being the Remainder of Erf 1098, Knysna, and measuring as such eight hundred and fifty- seven (857) square metres. Deed of Transfer 288/1972, dated 10 January 1972.

## Historical and architectural interest

This historical cottage, built of wood and corrugated iron, is the only remaining building from the days of the discovery of gold at Millwood, Knysna which was proclaimed a gold field in 1886.
