*Beskrywing*

Die restant van Erf 50282, te Nuweland, Kaapstad, met die historiese Vineyard-Hotel daarop, geleë in die stad Kaapstad, afdeling die Kaap, en groot twee komma vier twee drie vyf (2,423 5) hektaar.

*Historiese en argitektoniese belang*

Die oorspronklike gedeelte van die Vineyard-Hotel is tussen 1799 en 1800 deur Andrew Barnard en sy eggenote, Lady Anne, as 'n landelike woning in die Adamstyl gebou. Dit is deur die Barnards "The Vineyard" gedoop. Die natuurskoon van die terrein weerspieël nog steeds die tradisionele landelike karakter van Nuweland. 10/2/478.

*Beskrywing*

Die historiese Macroriehuis te Pietermaritzburg, met die erwe waarop dit geleë is, synde—

(a) Onderverdeling A van Perseel 1, Loopstraat, geleë in die stad en county Pietermaritzburg, provinsie Natal en groot ses-en-dertig (36) "perches";

(b) restant van Onderverdeling B van Perseel 1, Loopstraat, geleë in die stad en county Pietermaritzburg, provinsie Natal en groot eenduisend sewe-en-sewentig (1 077) vierkante voet;

(c) die restant van Onderverdeling C van Perseel 1, Loopstraat, geleë in die stad en county Pietermaritzburg, provinsie Natal, en groot vyfduisend vierhonderdeen-en-twintig (5 421) vierkante voet.

*Historical and architectural interest*

The foundation stone of this church was laid on 10 December 1855 and the church building itself was consecrated on 10 December 1856. The church is closely linked to the history of Simonstown. The music for the national anthem was composed in the adjoining parsonage, in 1921 by the then minister of the congregation, the Reverend M. L. de Villiers. 10/2/477.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the remainder of Erf 50282, at Newlands, Cape Town, with the historic Vineyard Hotel thereon, to be a national monument.

*Description*

The remainder of Erf 50282, at Newlands, Cape Town, with the historic Vineyard Hotel thereon, situate in the City of Cape Town, Division of the Cape, and measuring two comma four two three five (2,423 5) hectares.

Deed of Transfer 19427/1946, dated 9 November 1946.

*Historical and architectural interest*

The original part of the Vineyard Hotel was built in the Adam style between 1799 and 1800 by Andrew Barnard and his wife, Lady Anne, as a country residence. It was christened "The Vineyard" by the Barnards. The natural beauty of the grounds still reflects the traditional rural character of Newlands. 10/2/478.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the historic Macrorie House at Pietermaritzburg, with the erven on which it is situated, to be a national monument.

*Description*

The historic Macrorie House at Pietermaritzburg, with the erven on which it is situated, being—

(a) Subdivision A of Lot 1, Loop Street, situate in the City and County of Pietermaritzburg, Province of Natal, and measuring thirty-six (36) perches;

(b) remainder of Subdivision B of Lot 1, Loop Street, situate in the City and County of Pietermaritzburg, Province of Natal, and measuring one thousand and seventy-seven (1 077) square feet;

(c) the remainder of Subdivision C of Lot 1, Loop Street, situate in the City and County of Pietermaritzburg, Province of Natal, and measuring five thousand four hundred and twenty-one (5 421) square feet.

*Historiese belang*

*Wapen.*—Gevierendeel: 1, in blou, uitkomende van twee golwende versmalde dwarsbalke in die skildvoet, 'n galei in volle seil, vlag en wimpels wapperende na regs, alles van silwer; 2, in silwer, 'n Tudor-roos, geknop en gepunt van natuurlike kleur; 3, in silwer, 'n dissels gestingel en geblaar van natuurlike kleur; 4, in blou, 'n valhek van silwer; die skild gedek deur 'n muurkroon van rooi, gemessel en met 'n pylgleuf, albei van silwer.

*Wapenspreuk.*—UNUS ET IDEM.

*Historical interest*

Macrorie House was purchased in 1870 by Bishop W. A. K. Macrorie and occupied by him until his departure for England in 1892. This Victorian house is closely associated with the development of the Anglican Church in South Africa. 10/2/485.

The historic Ganesha Temple, situate on the remainder of Lot 22 on the Umhlanga River, County of Victoria, in extent one thousand seven hundred and thirty-eight (1 738) acres, one (1) rood and twenty-eight decimal five five eight (28,558) perches.

Deed of Transfer 1547/1921, dated 26 April 1921 (paragraph 8).

*Historical and architectural interest*

This Hindu temple is the first building by the well-known architect and builder, Kristappa Reddy. The building was erected in 1899 and forms a unique part of South Africa's cultural and architectural heritage. 10/2/484.
