

PROCLAMATION OF MONUMENT.

OAK TREES IN SWELLENGREBEL STREET,
SWELLENDAM.

It is hereby notified for general information that I, JOHANNES HENDRIKUS VILJOEN, Minister of Education, Arts and Science, have declared by virtue of the powers vested in me by section *eight* (1) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), the following as a monument:—

“ OAK TREES IN SWELLENGREBEL STREET,
SWELLENDAM.

All oak trees on both sides of Swellengrebel Street between the straight lines drawn from the northernmost beacon of La Belle Alliance (Diagram 382/1924) to the southernmost beacon of Skone Oord (Diagram 4559/1926) and from the southernmost beacon of Lot No. 1 (Diagram 820/1875) to the easternmost beacon of Portion No. 1 (Diagram 1502/1939) as shown on urban degree sheets A.J.IBB./W.32, A.J.IBB./W.41 and A.J.IBB./W.43.”
