

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969),

I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare Erf 14289, Kimberley, with the historic mining school building thereon, to be a national monument.

Description

Erf 14289, being portion of Erf 6516, Kimberley, with the historic mining school building thereon, situate in the Municipality and Administrative District of Kimberley and measuring one thousand seven hundred and thirty-seven (1 737) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 169/1975, dated 10 February 1975.

Historical and architectural interest

The historic mining school building was erected in the late Victorian architectural style in 1899 to house the first technical training school for the mining industry in South Africa. It is therefore closely associated with the development of the mining industry. (10/2/486.)
