

PROCLAMATION OF MONUMENT.

It is hereby notified for general information that I, JOHANNES HENDRIKUS VILJOEN, Minister of Education, Arts and Science, have declared, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section *eight* (1) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), the following as a monument:—

The lot is described as follows in Deed of Transfer No. 23920, dated 6th December, 1947, in name of Lance Lindenburg Tomlinson:—

“Certain piece of land situated in the Municipality and Division of Swellendam, measuring seven (7) square roods one hundred and twelve (112) square feet. Extending as this Deed of Grant with a diagram annexed issued in the favour of the subscribers for the erection of a building for the instruction of the Heathen on this 1st September, 1837 (Swellendam Freehold volume 5 No. 6) and a subsequent Deed of Transfer made in favour of the Board of Trustees of Swellendam Endeavour Lodge No. 125 in the International Order of Good Templars on this 31st October, 1924 No. 9946 will more fully point out.”
