Die historiese Kaaps-Hollandse herehuis, geleë op Plaas 654, synde sekere stuk gedeeltelik opgehefte erfpaggrond geleë te Klein Drakenstein, afdeling Paarl, synde gedeelte van die plaas Dekkers Valley en groot tien (10) morg dertig (30) vierkante roede [insluitende sewe (7) morg, vierhonderd ses-en-twintig (426) vierkante roede eiendomsgrond en twee (2) morg tweehonderd-en-vier (204) vierkante roede opgehefte erfpaggrond].

Die twee historiese Nederduits Gereformeerde Kerke, onderskeidelik in 1828 en 1874 gebou te Glen Lynden, Bedford, met drie meter grond om elke gebou en geleë op sekere stuk opgehefte erfpaggrond in die afdeling Bedford, synde Gedeelte 1 van die plaas Lynx Drift 54 en groot een-en-sestig duisend eenhonderd twee-en-sewentig (61 172) vierkante voet.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the historic Cape Dutch manor house on the farm Bergskadu's near Paarl to be a national monument.

Description

The historic Cape Dutch manor house, situate on Farm 654, being certain piece of partially abolished quitrent land situate at Klein Drakenstein, Division of Paarl, being portion of the farm Dekkers Valley and measuring ten (10) morgen, thirty (30) square roods [including seven (7) morgen, four hundred and twenty-six (426) square roods of freehold land and two (2) morgen, two hundred and four (204) square roods of abolished quitrent land].

Deed of Transfer 8023/1959, dated 19 June 1959 (Paragraph 1).

Historical and architectural interest

This historic Cape Dutch manor house was probably built in 1823 by Joshua Malherbe and has remained basically unaltered. 10/2/500.

Description

The two historic Dutch Reformed Churches, built in 1828 and 1874 respectively, situate at Glen Lynden, Bedford, with three metres of land around each building, situate on certain piece of abolished quitrent land in the Division of Bedford, being Portion 1 of the farm Lynx Drift 54 and measuring sixty-one thousand one hundred and seventy-two (61 172) square feet.

Certificate of Registered Title 2365/1964, dated 11 February 1964.

Historical and architectural interest

The older church, which dates from 1828, was erected in the simple vernacular style. It is T-shaped and, together with the other neighbouring church, which was erected in 1874 in the neo-Gothic style, it forms an important architectural group. 10/2/502.

Wapen.—In silwer, ondersteun van 'n blou kettinglose valhek versier van silwer, die middelste vertikale balke verleng en die ringe vervang deur oranje skywe, 'n Protea Cynaroides blomkop van oranje, blou geblaar en saamgevoer, die geheel binne-in 'n skildsoom, alles van blou.

Historical and architectural interest

This building was originally erected in 1868 as a primary school. It is an outstanding example of a Victoria school building and is closely associated with the history of Queenstown. 10/2/506.
