

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the old Market Hall, situate on Erf 3070, Mossel Bay, together with 2 metres of land on the front and sides and 5 metres of land at the rear, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the historic old Market Hall thereon, together with 2 metres of land on the front and sides and 5 metres of land at the rear, being a piece of land situate on Erf 3070, Mossel Bay, Village of Aliwal, Division of George, and measuring as such 16 square roods and 66 square feet.
