PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section *eight* of the Natural Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No.4 of 1934), as amended, I hereby proclaim St. Andrew's Church, Redbourne, Plettenbergbaai, to be a monument.

DESCRIPTION

St. Andrew's Church, Redbourne, Plettenbergbaai: Situated on Part B of the farm Roodefontein, now known as Redbourne, Division of Knysna, Province of the Cape of Good Hope, measuring 400 sq. roods 84 sq. feet as shown in Diagram No.10339/1903. Transferred to the Trustees of the Diocese of Cape Town on the 22nd February, 1906.

HISTORICAL INTEREST

The church was built in 1851 and is the oldest Anglican Church in the Diocese of George.
