

PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT.

It is hereby notified for general information that I, JOHANNES DE KLERK, Acting Minister of Education, Arts and Science, have declared, by virtue of the powers vested in me by section *eight (a)* of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), the following as a monument:—

OBJECT AND DESCRIPTION.

“Lower Need’s Camp”: The Figure ABCD represent 912 square feet of land and the line eA represents the western boundary of a passage five feet wide to the boundary AB from the King William’s Town-East London road, being Portion 1 (Lower Need’s Camp Monument) of Farm No. 46, situated in the Division of East London, Province of Cape of Good Hope, as shown in Diagram 10242/57, dated 12th November, 1957.
