DECLARATION OF THE DUTCH REFORMED
CHURCH (NAMIES) AT POFADDER

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare Erf 88, with the historic Dutch Reformed Church (Namies) thereon, as well as the surrounding fence, at Pofadder, to be a national monument.

Description

Erf 88, together with the historic Dutch Reformed Church building thereon, as well as the surrounding fence, at Pofadder, situate on certain piece of land being Lot C and measuring one (1) morgen, four hundred (400) square rods.

Crown Grant 12/1920, dated 15 January 1920.

Historical and architectural interest

This impressive church building which was officially consecrated in May 1922 is closely associated with the establishment and history of the Dutch Reformed Congregation (Namies). 10/2/577.
