DECLARATION OF THE HORSESHOE WATERFALL, SABIESHOEK, DISTRICT OF PILGRIM'S REST TRANSVAAL

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Horseshoe Waterfall, situate on the remainder of the farm Sabieshoek 200 JT, District of Pilgrim's Rest, Transvaal, to be a national monument.

Description

The property, with the Horseshoe Waterfall thereon, as indicated by the figure A B C D E A on Surveyor's Diagram SG A3967/77 of 2 August 1977 filed in the office of the Surveyor-General in Pretoria, and situated on certain remaining extent of the quitrent farm Sabieshoek 135 situate in the District of Pilgrim's Rest (formerly No. 871, District of Lijdenburg), measuring 7 720 square metres.

Deed of Transfer 13598/1927, dated 16 November 1927.

Natural interest

This waterfall and the basin into which it gradually cascades, as well as the banks of the basin with the surrounding cliffs covered in indigenous plants, form an essential part of the natural beauty of this area. 10/2/598.
