

NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF ZONNEBLOEM COTTAGES,
CAPE TOWN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare Erven 12505 and 12522, Cape Town, together with the buildings thereon known as Zonnebloem Cottages, to be a national monument.

Description

The property, with the buildings known as Zonnebloem Cottages thereon, situated on—

(1) certain land situate in the City of Cape Town, Cape Division, being Erf 12505, Cape Town at Woodstock, and measuring seven hundred and fourteen (714) square metres; and

(2) certain land situate as above, being Erf 12522 Cape Town at Woodstock and measuring seven hundred and fourteen (714) square metres.
