

NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF BLEAK HOUSE, BATHURST

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the remainder of Erf 86, Bathurst, together with the house known as Bleak House thereon, to be a national monument.

Description

The property, with the house known as Bleak House thereon, being certain piece of land situate in the Municipality and Division of Bathurst, being the remainder of Erf 86, Bathurst, and measuring one thousand four hundred and sixty-three (1 463) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 23320/1974, dated 24 July 1974.

Historical and architectural interest

This double-storeyed stone building is a typical Bathurst cottage of the 1820-period. 10/2/614.
