NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE REFORMED CHURCH, COLESBERG

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare Erf 375, Colesberg, with the historic Reformed Church building thereon, to be a national monument.

Description

Certain piece of land, being Erf 375, Colesberg, with the historic Reformed Church building thereon, situate in the Municipality of Colesberg, and measuring thirty-one (31) square roods and thirty-six (36) square feet.

Deed of Transfer 286/1869, dated 29 September 1869.

Historical and architectural interest

This church, the foundation stone of which was laid on 15 March 1862, was built in an adapted neo-Gothic style. It is one of the few remaining sandstone buildings in Colesberg. 10/2/505.
