DECLARATION OF "KLEIN VREDENBURG" AT PAARL

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Willem Adriaan Cruywagen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property known as "Klein Vredenburg", with the historic buildings thereon, at Paarl, to be a national monument.

Description

The property known as "Klein Vredenburg", with the historic buildings thereon, being certain piece of land situate in the subdivided estate Brug Street in the Municipality and Division of Paarl, being Erf 2342, Paarl, and measuring two thousand eight hundred and eighteen (2818) square metres.

Historical and architectural interest

The dwelling-house is a typical Georgian doublestoreyed town house which, in its present form, dates from about the middle of the nineteenth century. The group of buildings forms an integral part of the historic core of Paarl. 10/2/644.
