NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF PROPERTY WITH DUTCH REFORMED CHURCH BUILDING AND PAR-SONAGE THEREON AT THREE ANCHOR BAY, CAPE TOWN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Willem Adriaan Cruywagen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the Dutch Reformed church building and parsonage thereon at Three Anchor Bay, Cape Town, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the Dutch Reformed church building and parsonage of the congregation of Three Anchor Bay thereon and described as certain piece of land situate in the Cape District at Green Point, being the remaining extent of a portion of Subdivided Lot 16 and measuring two hundred and eight square roods and forty-eight square feet.
