By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the house known as Domira, with 30 metres of surrounding land, situated on the Lovedale Mission Station at Alice, to be a national monument.

Description

The historic house known as Domira, with 30 metres of surrounding land, situated on certain piece of land, being Erf 1049, Alice, situate in the Municipality of Alice, Division of Victoria East, and measuring one hundred and thirty-seven decimal five one three nought (137,513 0) hectares.

Deed of Transfer 31001/1973, dated 19 October 1973.

Historiese en argitektoniese belang

Domira was die woning van Charles Lennox Stretch, diplomatieke agent by die Gaikas (1836-1846). Dit het ook gedien as vesting, stormsentrum en aanvanklik die hoofkwartier van Sir Andries Stockenström gedurende die Oorlog van die Byl. 10/2/683.

Beskrywing

Die fasade van die Crozierhuis, geleë op sekere stuk grond in die dorp en afdeling Stellenbosch, gemerk op Algemene Plan 11, synde die resterende gedeelte van Persele 11 en 12 en groot per resterende gedeelte eenhonderd-en-vyf vierkante roede en eenhonderd nege-en-twintig vierkante voet.

Transportakte 431/1920, gedateer 17 Januarie 1920.

Historiese en argitektoniese belang

Hierdie laat-negentiende-eeuse gebou se fasade het besonderhede Victoriaanse en Georgiaanse kenmerke. Die Crozierhuis het vroeër deel gevorm van die ou "College Square" van die Victoria-kollege. 10/2/673.

Beskrywing

Die fasade van die Stasiegebou, geleë op 'n gedeelte van die restant van sekere stuk grond synde Point SAR 1 No. 13200, geleë in die stad Durban, provinsie Natal.

Sertifikaat van Gewysigde Titel van Konsolidasie 1872/1944, gedateer 22 Maart 1944.

Historiese en argitektoniese belang

Hierdie Victoriaanse spoorwegstasie dateer uit die negentigerjare van die vorige eeu toe die Natalse Staatspoorweë 'n bloeitydperk beleef het. Veral die gietysterveranda en die baksteen-en-okkerwerk op die fasade is noemenswaardig. 10/2/674.

DECLARATION OF THE FACADE OF THE
CROZIER HOUSE AT STELLENBOSCH

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the facade of Crozier House in Victoria Street, Stellenbosch, to be a national monument.

Description

The facade of Crozier House, situated on certain piece of land, situate in the Town and Division of Stellenbosch, marked on General Plan 11, being the remaining extent of Lots 11 and 12, and measuring as per remaining extent one hundred and five square roods and one hundred and twenty-nine square feet.

Deed of Transfer 431/1920, dated 17 January 1920.

Historical and architectural interest

The facade of this late-nineteenth-century building has notable Victorian and Georgian characteristics. The Crozier House earlier formed part of the old College Square of the Victoria College. 10/2/673.

STATION BUILDING AT POINT ROAD,
DURBAN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the facade of the Station Building at Point Road, Durban, to be a national monument.

Description

The facade of the Station Building, situate on a portion of the remainder of a certain piece of land being Point SAR 1 No. 13200, situate in the City of Durban, Province of Natal.

Certificate of Amended Title of Consolidation 1872/1944, dated 22 March 1944.

Historical and architectural interest

This Victorian railway station dates from the eighteen-nineties when the Natal Government Railways experienced a boom. The wrought iron verandah and the brick and ochre work on the facade are of special interest. 10/2/674.
