In 1881 the “Genootskap van Regte Afrikaners” decided to establish the Huguenot Memorial School. The building was erected in 1882–1883 and served as a school until 1910. It was originally a Georgian double-storeyed building and was the first school to use Afrikaans as its medium of instruction. 10/2/724.
