

## NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

## DECLARATION OF THE HISTORIC CORBELLED HUT SITUATED ON SPRING FARM IN THE DISTRICT OF GRAHAMSTOWN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the historic corbelled hut situated on the farm known as Spring Farm, in the District of Grahamstown, to be a national monument.

*Description*

The historic corbelled hut situated on certain redeemed quitrent land called Spring Farm situate in the Division of Albany.

Deed of Transfer 15695/1958, dated 30 October 1958.

*Historical and architectural interest*

This corbelled hut is an excellent example of the ingenuity of the early pioneers in building a house with the only material at their disposal and is therefore an important link in the development of vernacular architecture in South Africa. 10/2/748.
