

## NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE DUTCH REFORMED  
CHURCH, BRANDVLEI

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the Dutch Reformed Church building thereon, at Brandvlei, to be a national monument.

*Description*

The property with the historic church building thereon, being a certain piece of land called The Square (now known as Erf 138), situate in the Township of Brandvlei, Division of Calvinia, and measuring one (1) morgen, two hundred and six (206) square roods and one hundred and twenty-five (125) square feet.

*Historical and architectural interest*

The foundation-stone of this neo-Gothic church was laid on 15 July 1905. The building was completed and inaugurated at the end of 1905. 10/2/740.
