Beskrywing

Die eiendom bekend as Cuyler Manor, met die historiese geboue enstrukture daarop, synde ongeveer sewe hektaar grond geleë op Plaas 320/1, distrik Uitenhage, en begrens aan die noordekant deur TR 15/1, aan die suide- en die westekant deur grond ont-eien deur die Suid-Afrikaanse Spoerweë vir spoorwegwerkswinkels, en aan die ooste-kant deur 'n lyn wat parallel met die westelike grens van Plaas 320/1 loop op 'n afstand van 260 meter oos daarvan, soos aangegeven op Diagram 2052 1B wat gelasseer is in die kantore van die Municipaliiteit van Uitenhage en die Raad vir Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede.

and the stand's eastern boundary, situated on the property described as certain Stand 299, situate on Du Toit and Vermeulen Streets, in the City of Pretoria, measuring 71 020 (seventy-one thousand and twenty) square feet.

Historical and architectural interest

The corner-stone of this church building, which was designed in the style of the Dutch Renaissance, was laid on 18 July 1904 by General Louis Botha and the building was taken into use on 24 February 1905. It is the oldest Nederduitsch Hervormde Church building in Pretoria and its history is closely interwoven with the history of the development of the Afrikaans suster churches in the Transvaal. 10/2/759.

DECLARATION OF THE CUYLER MANOR HOMESTEAD, AT UITENHAGE

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare a portion of the original Cuyler Manor farm, with the historic dwelling, as well as the visitors' house, coach-house, wagon-house and mill-house thereon, at Uitenhage, to be a national monument.

Description

The property known as Cuyler Manor with the historic buildings and structures thereon, being approximately seven hectares of land situate on Farm 320/1, District of Uitenhage, and bounded on the northern side by TR 15/1, on the southern and western sides by the land appropriated by the South African Railways for railway workshops and on the eastern side by a line running parallel to the western boundary of Farm 320/1 at a distance of 260 metres east thereof, as shown on Diagram 2052 1B which is filed in the offices of the Municipality of Uitenhage and the National Monuments Council.

Historical and architectural interest

This predominantly Cape Dutch homestead was erected in 1814 by Colonel Jacob Glen Cuyler, landdrost of Uitenhage. Colonel Cuyler was closely associated with the settlement of the British Settlers of 1820. 10/2/757.

Description

The Old Stables, also known as the Guard House, situated on certain piece of land at Simonstown, in the Municipality of Simonstown, Division of the Cape, being portion South Oatlands C, a part of the piece of land known as Company's Garden.

Deed of Transfer 15038/1961, dated 27 October 1961.

Historical and architectural interest

This building was originally erected in the eighteenth century as stables for the well-known Oatlands property. Shortly after the Second British Occupation of the Cape it served as a guard house for some time. 10/2/763.

DECLARATION OF THE MALHERBE HOUSE ON THE FARM KLEINBOSCH, AT DAL JOSAFAT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the historic Malherbe House with one metre of surrounding land, situated on the farm Kleinbosch, at Dal Josafat, to be a national monument.

Description

The historic Malherbe House with one metre of surrounding land, situated on certain piece of land, partly freehold and partly redeemed quitrent, being the farm Kleinbosch B, situate in the Division of Paarl.

Deed of Transfer 15498/1972, dated 3 July 1972.

Historical and architectural interest

This Victorian house dates from the middle of the nineteenth century and was originally the dwelling of Petrus Jacobus Malherbe, founder member of the "Genootskap van Regte Afrikaners". 10/2/761.

DECLARATION OF THE ROCK FORMATION KNOWN AS THE LETTERKLIP, NEAR GARIES

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the rock formation known as the Letterklip thereon, near Garies, to be a national monument.

Description

The property, consisting of one hectare of land with the rock formation known as the Letterklip thereon, being certain piece of abolished quitrent land, situate in the Division of Namaqualand, being the remainder of Erf 166, Garies.
