VERKLARING VAN DIE HISTORIESE BEESDIP TE ELANDSPUTTE, DISTRIK LICHTENBURG

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby die historiese beesdip, geleë op Gedeelte 1 van die plaas Uitgevonden 355 JP, distrik Lichtenburg, Transvaal, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

Beskrywing

Die eiendom, met historiese beesdip daarop, beskryf soos volg: Die figuur ABCWA stel voor 203 vierkante meter, synde 'n nasionale gedenkwaardigheidsterrein geleë op Gedeelte 1 van die plaas Uitgevonden 355, Registrasie-afdeling JP, Transvaal, soos getoon op Landmetersdiagram LG A711/80, gedateer 26 Maart 1980 en geliasseer in die kantoor van die Landmeter-generaal in Pretoria.

Transportakte 36451/1966, gedateer 24 November 1966.

Historiese belang

Tydens die konstruksie van hierdie beesdip het mnr. J. A. Voorendyk in Desember 1924 'n diamant ontdek, wat gelei het tot die ontdekking van verdere diamante op Elandsputte ('n gedeelte van Uitgevonden) en die uiteindelijke skouspelagtige diamantstormlope op Elandsputte in 1926 en op Grasfontein in 1927. In 1927 het diamantproduksie op die Lichtenburg-delwey 'n hoogtepunt bereik toe 2 100 861 karaat opgeweer is, wat byna die ineenstorting van die Suid-Afrikaanse diamantmark tot gevolg gehad het. 10/2/785.

NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE HISTORIC CATTLE-DIP AT ELANDSPUTTE, DISTRICT OF LICHTENBURG

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the historic cattle-dip, situated on Portion 1 of the farm Uitgevonden 355 JP, District of Lichtenburg, Transvaal, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the historic cattle-dip thereon, described as follows: The figure ABCWA represents 203 square metres, being a national monument site situated on Portion 1 of the farm Uitgevonden 355, Registration Division JP, Transvaal, as shown on Surveyor's Diagram SG A711/80, dated 26 March 1980, and filed in the Office of the Surveyor-General in Pretoria.

Deed of Transfer 36451/1966, dated 24 November 1966.

Historical interest

In December 1924, during the construction of this cattle-dip, Mr J. A. Voorendyk discovered a diamond which led to the further discovery of diamonds on Elandsputte (a portion of Uitgevonden) and the eventual spectacular "diamond rushes" on Elandsputte in 1926 and Grasfontein in 1927. In 1927 diamond production on the Lichtenburg diggings reached a peak when 2 100 861 carats were produced, which nearly resulted in the collapse of South Africa's diamond market. 10/2/785.
