DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE HOUSE KNOWN AS ZORGVLIET THEREON, GARDENS, CAPE TOWN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the house known as Zorgvliet thereon, situated in Sir George Grey Street, Gardens, Cape Town, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the house known as Zorgvliet thereon, namely certain piece of land situate in the City of Cape Town, Cape Division, being the remainder of Erf 182, Oranjezicht, and measuring one thousand six hundred and four (1 604) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 8552/1969, dated 11 April 1969.

Historical and architectural interest

This house with its Cape Dutch and Victorian characteristics is situated on one of the oldest properties in the Cape Province. The property was granted to Matthys Coeymans as early as 1669. 10/2/818.
