DECLARATION OF THE OLD MILITARY COMMISSARIAT STORE, MILITARY RESERVE, KING WILLIAM'S TOWN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Old Commissariat Store in the so-called Military Reserve, King William's Town, to be a national monument.

Description

The Old Commissariat Store in the so-called Military Reserve, situated on Erf 511, King William's Town, in the Municipality and Division of King William's Town, Province of the Cape of Good Hope.

Historical and architectural interest

This L-shaped stone building was completed in 1849, shortly before the outbreak of the Eighth Frontier War (1850–1853). It was also used in times of peace, for example to store corn in 1857 during the so-called Xhosa Suicide. 10/2/844.
