

NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE HISTORIC VLAKKELAND FARMSTEAD THEREON, WITH INCLUSION OF ALL THE BUILDINGS AS WELL AS THE SURROUNDING RING WALL, AT ONDER-DAL JOSAFAT, DISTRICT OF PAARL

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Vijloen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the historic Vlakkeland farmstead thereon, with inclusion of the main dwelling-house, the wine cellar and barn, together with the surrounding ring wall, situate at Onder-Dal Josafat, District of Paarl, to be a national monument.

Description

The property, together with the historic Vlakkeland homestead complex as well as the surrounding ring wall, situate on certain piece of land partly in the Municipality and Division of Paarl, being the remainder of Erf 8370, Paarl, and measuring ten comma two two nine one (10,2291) hectares.

Deed of Transfer 4156/1980, dated 31 October 1980.

Historical and architectural interest

This Cape-Dutch complex, as well as the surrounding ring wall, presumably dates from the years 1790-1800 and was previously the farmstead of the farm Vlakkeland which was granted to Jean Roux, a Huguenot, in 1694. 10/2/866.
