

## NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

## DECLARATION OF THE DROSTDY HOTEL, SITUATED AT 28 CHURCH STREET, GRAAFF-REINET

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the historic Drostdy Hotel thereon, situated at 28 Church Street, Graaff-Reinet, to be a national monument.

*Description*

The property with the Drostdy Hotel thereon, being certain land situate in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet, being Erf 1180, Graaff-Reinet, and measuring three thousand three hundred and four (3 304) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 4013/1975, dated 26 February 1975.

*Historical and architectural interest*

This building was designed by Louis Michel Thibault and erected in 1804–1806. It served as a drostdy until 1847 and since 1876 it has been used almost uninterruptedly as a hotel. The building has changed much since its erection but was recently fully restored. 10/2/847.
