## NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

## DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY TOGETHER WITH THE HISTORIC GIRLS' PUBLIC SCHOOL THEREON, AT BEAUFORT-WEST

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property together with the historic Girls' Public School thereon, at Beaufort West, to be a national monument.

## Description

The property together with the historic Girls' Public School thereon, situate on certain piece of land, being the remainder of Erf 583, Beaufort West, in the Municipality and Division of Beaufort West, and measuring one hundred and thirty-eight (138) square roods thirty-seven (37) square feet and one hundred and sixteen (116) square inches.

Deed of Transfer 7356/1958, dated 30 May 1958.

## Historical and architectural interest

The original Girls' Public School building was opened October 1879. An east wing was added in 1879. It is a fine example of Victorian public architecture and a building of considerable importance in Beaufort West. 10/2/865.
