DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE HISTORIC CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH THEREON, SITUATED AT 1 HIGH STREET, CRADOCK

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the historic old Congregational Church building thereon, situated at 1 High Street, Cradock, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the historic Congregational Church building thereon, situate on certain piece of land, in the Municipality and Division of Cradock, being Erf 1227, Cradock, and measuring five thousand two hundred and four (5 204) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 15315/1981, dated 8 April 1981.

Historical and architectural interest

This neo-Gotic church was erected in 1853 by the Revd. Robert Barry Taylor, the then missionary in Cradock of the London Mission Society. It is a replica of the Harpenden Chapel in England. 10/2/917.
