(f) No. 2 Meadway, Pinelands:

Certain land situate in the Cape Division in the Municipality of Pinelands, being Erf 110, Pinelands, and measuring one thousand three hundred and seventy-one (1 371) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 1463, dated 14 January 1981.

Historical and architectural interest

The Pinelands Garden City originated with Richard Stuttaford, who actively promoted this new concept. The town planner and architect, Albert J. Thompson, drew up the plans in 1919. In 1923 the original section known as The Meadway was laid out and built on State land that previously formed part of Uitvlugt Forest Reserve.
