

WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE SO-CALLED TIME BALL
TOWER SITUATED IN THE TABLE BAY HARBOUR
AT CAPE TOWN, TOGETHER WITH ONE METRE OF
SURROUNDING LAND

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the so-called Time Ball Tower, situated on Erf 1 in the Table Bay Harbour at Cape Town, together with one metre of surrounding land, to be a national monument.

Description

The so-called Time Ball Tower, together with one metre of surrounding land, situated on certain piece of land, being the Remainder of Erf 1, Cape Town, in the Municipality of Cape Town, Cape Division.
