

WARGRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE OLD
LIBRARY BUILDING THEREON, SITUATED IN
CHURCH STREET, BEAUFORT WEST

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property, together with the Old Library Building thereon, situated in Church Street, Beaufort West, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the Old Library Building thereon, namely certain piece of land, being Erf 584, Beaufort West, situate in the Municipality and Division of Beaufort West and measuring twelve (12) square rods, seventy-one comma three two (71,32) square feet.

Deed of Transfer 23653/1964, dated 16 November 1964.

Historical and architectural interest

This impressive Edwardian building, with its neo-classical features, was erected by Matthew Deas, master-builder of Beaufort West. The front gable bears the date 1906. 10/2/933.
