

WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969DECLARATION OF THREE PROPERTIES WITH THE
BUILDINGS THEREON, SITUATED IN THE ORIGINAL
PINELANDS GARDEN CITY AREA KNOWN AS
THE MEADWAY, PINELANDS, TOGETHER WITH
THE ROAD RESERVE CALLED MEADWAY AND THE
OPEN SPACE KNOWN AS THE MEAD

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the three properties with the buildings thereon, together with the road reserve called Meadway and the open space known as The Mead, as more fully described below, situated in the original Pinelands Garden City area known as The Meadway, Pinelands, to be national monuments.

Description

The three properties with the buildings thereon, together with the road reserve called Meadway and the open space known as The Mead, namely:

(a) 1 Meadway, Pinelands:

(i) Certain piece of a land being Erf 126, Pinelands, situate in the Municipality of Pinelands, Cape Division, and measuring one thousand and fifty-seven (1 057) square metres; and

(ii) certain piece of land, being Erf 127, Pinelands, situate as above and measuring five hundred and thirty-five (535) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 49430/1980, dated 12 December 1980.

(b) 10 Meadway, Pinelands:

Certain piece of land situate in the Cape Division in the Municipality of Pinelands, being Erf 114, Pinelands, and measuring one thousand three hundred and twelve (1 312) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 15208/1977, dated 22 June 1977.

(c) 16 Meadway, Pinelands:

Certain piece of land situate in the Municipality of Pinelands, Division of the Cape, being Erf 117, Pinelands, and measuring nine hundred and forty-eight (948) square metres.

Deed of Transfer 39799/1975, dated 15 December 1975.
