DECLARATION OF THE VICTORIAN DOUBLE-STO-REYED SHOP BUILDING, SITUATED AT 173 BREË STREET, CAPE TOWN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Victorian double-storeyed shop building, situated at 173 Breë Street, Cape Town, to be a national monument.

Description

The Victorian double-storeyed shop building, situate on certain piece of land in the City of Cape Town, Cape Division, being Remainder of Erf 3289, Cape Town at Cape Town.

Deed of Transfer 5786/1982, dated 16 February 1982.

Historical and architectural interest

In its present form this Victorian double-storeyed shop building with its cast-iron balcony dates from the end of the nineteenth century. 10/2/1010.
