DECLARATION OF THE FAÇADES OF FIFTY (50) HOUSES IN THE HISTORICAL CORE OF GRAAFF-REINET, FORTY-THREE (43) SITUATED IN CRADOCK STREET AND SEVEN (7) ADJOINING CHURCH SQUARE

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the façades of fifty (50) houses in the historical core of Graaff-Reinet, forty-three (43) situated in Cradock Street and seven (7) adjoining Church Square, as more fully described below, to be national monuments.

Description

The façades of the fifty (50) houses as situated on the undermentioned properties:

(1) 7 Cradock Street, Graaff-Reinet:

Certain piece of land, being the Remainder of Erf 2100, Graaff-Reinet, situate in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet.

- (2) 15 Cradock Street, Graaff-Reinet:
- (i) Certain piece of land, being Erf 72, Graaff-Reinet, situate in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet; and

(3) 37 Cradock Street, Graaff-Reinet:

Certain piece of land, being Erf 238, Graaff-Reinet, situate in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet.
