DECLARATION OF THE FAÇADES OF FORTY-EIGHT (48) HOUSES IN THE HISTORICAL CORE OF GRAAFF-REINET, SITUATED IN CROSS STREET, TE WATER STREET, PARK STREET, STOKENSTROOM STREET, MULLER STREET, PARLIAMENT STREET, NAPIER STREET AND CALEDON STREET

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the façades of forty-eight (48) houses in the historical core of Graaff-Reinet, situated in Cross Street, Te Water Street, Park Street, Stockenstroom Street, Muller Street, Parliament Street, Napier Street, and Caledon Street, as more fully described below to be national monuments.

## Description

The façades of the forty-eight (48) houses as situated on the undermentioned properties:

(1) 4 Cross Street, Graaff-Reinet:

Certain piece of freehold land, being Erf 1511, Graaff-Reinet, situate in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet

Deed of Transfer 1888/1971, dated 28 January 1971.

(2) 7 Cross Street, Graaff-Reinet:

Certain piece of land, being Erf 1519, Graaff-Reinet, situate in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet.

Deed of Transfer 10473/1980, dated 25 April 1980.

(3) 1 Te Water Street, Graaff-Reinet:

Certain piece of land, being Erf 1486, Graaff-Reinet, situate in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet.

Deed of Transfer 38449/1980, dated 14 October 1980.

(4) 3 Te Water Street, Graaff-Reinet:

Certain piece of land, being Erf 1487, Graaff-Reinet, situate in the Municipality and Division of Graaff-Reinet.

Deed of Transfer 2480/1973, dated 2 February 1973.
