

WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE SO-
CALLED COETZEE HOUSE THEREON, SITUATED
AT 51 PIET RETIEF STREET, BURGERSDORP

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the so-called Coetzee house thereon, situated at 51 Piet Retief Street, Burgersdorp, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the so-called Coetzee house thereon, situate on certain piece of land, being Erf 186, Burgersdorp, in the Municipality of Burgersdorp, Division of Albert, and 672 (six hundred and seventy-two) square metres in extent.

Deed of Transfer 21785/1975, dated 28 July 1975.

Historical and architectural interest

This cottage in the typical Karoo style was erected shortly after the founding of Burgersdorp. It was originally the town house of the Coetzees of the farm Swartfontein. 10/2/1031.
