

**WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969**

**DECLARATION OF THE PROPERTY WITH THE SO-
CALLED DE BRUIN HOUSE THEREON, SITUATED IN
VAN DER WALT STREET, BURGERSDORP**

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property with the so-called De Bruin house thereon, situated in Van der Walt Street, Burgersdorp, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the so-called De Bruin house thereon, situate on certain piece of land, in the Municipality of Burgersdorp, Division of Albert, being the Remainder of Erf 183, Burgersdorp, and 101 (one hundred and one) square metres in extent.

Deed of Transfer 31095/1974, dated 16 September 1974.

Historical and architectural interest

This cottage in the typical Karoostyle was erected shortly after the founding of Burgersdorp. It was originally the town house of the De Bruins of Witkop. 10/2/1030.
