WAR GRAVES AND NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THREE PROPERTIES, INCLUDING THE HISTORIC DWELLING-HOUSES THEREON, SITUATED AT 18, 20 AND 24 ELSMERE ROAD, KIMBERLEY

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the War Graves and National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Gerrit van Niekerk Viljoen, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the three properties, including the historic dwelling-houses thereon, situated at 18, 20 and 24 Elsmere Road, Kimberley, to be national monuments.

Description.

The three properties with the dwelling-houses thereon, described as follows:

(a) 18 Elsmere Road, Kimberley:

Certain Erf 565, situate in the Municipality of the City of Kimberley, Division of Kimberley, and one thousand eight hundred and five (1 805) square metres in extent.

Deed of Transfer 1054/1974, dated 30 July 1974.

(b) 20 Elsmere Road, Kimberley:

Certain Erf 566, situate in the Municipality of the City of Kimberley, Division of Kimberley, and one thousand six hundred and twenty-four (1 624) square metres in extent.

Deed of Transfer 466/1980, dated 15 April 1980.

(c) 24 Elsmere Road, Kimberley:

Certain Erf 568 (previously 993), situate in the Municipality of the City of Kimberley, Division of Kimberley, and nine thousand five hundred and twenty-eight (9 528) square feet in extent.

Deed of Transfer 30/1963, dated 16 January 1963.

Historical and architectural interest

This impressive row of houses with their Victorian and Edwardian features forms an integral part of the architectural street scene of Elsmere Road and is in itself also an attractive architectural unit. 10/2/1047.
