PROVISIONAL DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT.—THE PROPERTY INCLUSIVE OF THE HOUSE KNOWN AS THE OWL HOUSE, AS WELL AS THE CAMEL YARD THEREON, SITUATED AT 306 RIVER STREET, NIEU-BETHESDA

In terms of section 5 (1) (c) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act No. 28 of 1969), the National Monuments Council hereby provisionally declares the property inclusive of the house known as the Owl House, as well as the Camel Yard thereon, situated at 306 River Street, Nieu-Bethesda, as fully described below, to be a national monument.

The property inclusive of the house known as the Owl House, as well as the Camel Yard thereon, including the contents of both being Erf 306, Nieu-Bethesda, situated in the Municipality of Nieu-Bethesda, Division of Graaff-Reinet, in extent 991 (nine hundred and ninety-one) square metres.
