VERKLARING VAN DIE MOFFAT- EN DIE HAMILTON-HUIS EN DIE WAENHUIS BY DIE SENDINGSTASIE, KURUMAN

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby die Moffat- en die Hamilton-huis, asook die waenhuis, tesame met ses meter grond om elke gebou, geleë op die resterende gedeelte van Erf 5, Kuruman, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

Beskrywing

Die eiendom met die Moffat- en die Hamilton-huis, sowel as die waenhuis daarop, tesame met ses meter grond om elke gebou, geleë op die resterende gedeelte van Erf 5 en beskryf as 'n stuk grond, groot 252 morg en 416 vierkante roede, geleë in die afdeling Kuruman.

Kuruman-erfpagte, Boekdeel I (No. 11), gedateer 15 Maart 1888.

Historiese en argitektoniese belang

Die Moffat- en die Hamilton-huis, en die waenhuis, tesame met die reeds verklaarde Sendingkerk, vorm die kern van die beroemde Kuruman-sendingstasie wat in 1824 deur Robert Moffat gestig is. 10/2/581.

NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, NO. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE MOFFAT AND HAMILTON HOUSES, AND THE COACH-HOUSE AT THE MISSION STATION, KURUMAN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Pieter Gerhardus Jacobus Koornhof, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Moffat and Hamilton houses, as well as the coach-house, together with six metres of ground surrounding each, situated on the remainder of Erf 5, Kuruman, to be a national monument.

Description

The property with the Moffat and Hamilton houses, as well as the coach-house thereon, together with six metres of ground surrounding each, situated on the remainder of Erf 5 and described as a piece of land measuring 252 morgen and 416 square roods, situated in the Division of Kuruman.

Kuruman Quitrent-tenure Volume I (No. 11), dated 15 March 1888.

Historical and architectural interest

The Moffat and Hamilton houses and the coach-house, together with the already proclaimed Mission Church, form the nucleus of the famous Kuruman Mission established by Robert Moffat in 1824. 10/2/581.
