RELICS AND ANTIQUES ACT, 1934.

PROTECTION OF MONUMENTS.

Under section *eight* of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), I, RICHARD STUTTAFORD, Minister of the Interior, do hereby proclaim the objects set out in the Schedule below to be monuments in terms of paragraph (a) of that section.

SCHEDULE.

1. THE PROVINCE OF THE TRANSVAAL.

Dzata Ruins, District Zoutpansberg	In the Njelele Valley, Portion named Dzata, in extent 5.4006 morgen, of the farm Mpefu No. 467, in the District of Zoutpansberg.
Klapperkop and Skanskop Forts, Pretoria	On the farm Groenkloof No. 419, District Pretoria.

IN THE PROVINCE OF NATAL.

Voortrekker Kommandant Karel Pieter Landman's Home	On the "werf" of the farm Uithoek No. 1335, in the County of Klip River, Ladysmith, Natal.
"Wagon Hill", to include the 40-feet right-of-way from the Ladysmith Town lands to and including Sub-Wagon Hill of the farm Fourie's Kraal No. 1183, and Sub-Wagon Hill of Sub-G, of the farm Riet Kuil No. 1067	On portions of the farms Fourie's Kraal No. 1183, and Riet Kuil No. 1067, District Ladysmith.
Shaka Memorial.....	In the town of Stanger, in the County of Victoria, Province of Natal.

"Martello Tower", Fort Beaufort	In the grounds of the Mental Hospital, Fort Beaufort.
Fort Murray.....	On Fort Murray Outspan, Division of Kingwilliamstown.
Old Drostdy, Swellendam..	Swellendam.
Astronomical Relics, Touws River	In the grounds of the Douglas Hotel, Touws River.
Tower and adjacent Walls of Fort Brown	In the District of Albany.
Donkin Reserve.....	Donkin Reserve, Port Elizabeth.
Drostdy Gates, Grahamstown	On grounds situated in the City of Grahamstown, Albany Division, being the Drostdy Gate Buildings, part of Lot A of the Drostdy Military Reserve granted to the Mayor of Grahamstown and others as Trustees of the Undenominational Public School on the 28th April, 1886.
First Gold Power Plant Site, Pietersburg	Certain Portion "A", known as First Gold Power Plant Site, of the quitrent farm Eersteling No. 87, in the District of Pietersburg.
First Gold Crushing Site, Pietersburg	Certain Portion "B", known as First Gold Crushing Site, of the quitrent farm Eersteling No. 87, in the District of Pietersburg.
