DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the property in Somerset East, with the old Parsonage thereon, to be a national monument.

Description

Certain land, with the historic building thereon, situate in the Municipality and Division of Somerset East, being the remainder of Erf 5, Somerset East, measuring as such 3,6488 hectares, Deed of Transfer 5123/1971, dated 26 Februarie 1971.

Historical and Architectural Interest

This double-storeyed Georgian building was erected about 1820 as the headquarters of the Somerset Experimental Farm. From 1825 to 1829 it was used as the Drostdy, after which it was transferred to the Wesleyan Church. From 1834 to 1944 the property belonged to the Dutch Reformed Church and the building was used as a parsonage.

DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the charcoal oven on the farm "Voorhuis 2", in the District of Swellendam, to be a national monument.

Description

The historic charcoal oven, including the fenced area, situate about 50 metres west of the banks of the Leeu River and about 40 metres east of the north-eastern corner of the kraal on the farm described as certain piece of abolished quitrent land, situate in the Division of Swellendam, being the farm "Voorhuis 2", measuring 809 morgen, Deed of Transfer 9467/1961, dated 11 July 1961.

Historical Interest

This charcoal oven was built about the middle of the 18th century by Hermanus Steyn and is the oldest known structure of its kind in South Africa.

Description

A five-sided area which is marked by beacons, with the fossilised reptile footprints thereon, measuring about 1,6 hectares, situated about 300 metres south of the main

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby die eiendom in Somerset-Oos met die ou Pastorie daarop, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

Beskrywing

Sekere grond, met die historiese gebou daarop geleë in die munisipaliteit en afdeling Somerset-Oos, synde die restant van Erf 5, Somerset-Oos, groot as sodanige 3,6488 hektaar, Transportakte 5123/1971, gedateer 26 Februarie 1971.

Historiese en Argitektoniese Belang

Hierdie Georgiëanse gebou in die dubbelverdieping-styl is teen 1820 opgerig as hoofkwartier van die Somerset-proefplaas. Van 1825 tot 1829 is dit as Drostdy gebruik, waarna dit aan die Wesleyaanse Kerk oorgedra is. Van 1834 tot 1944 was die eiendom in besit van die Nederduits Gereformeerde Kerk en het die gebou as pastorie diens gedoen.

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by artikel 10 (1) van die Wet op Nasionale Gedenkwaardighede, 1969 (Wet 28 van 1969), verklaar ek, Johannes Petrus van der Spuy, Minister van Nasionale Opvoeding, hierby die houtskooloond op die plaas Voorhuis 2, in die distrik Swellendam, tot nasionale gedenkwaardigheid.

Beskrywing

Die historiese houtskooloond, met inbegrip van die omheinde gedeelte, geleë ongeveer 50 meter ten weste van die oewers van die Leeurivier en ongeveer 40 meter ten ooste van die nooroostelike hoek van die kraal op die plaas wat beskryf word as sekere stuk opgehefte erfpaggrond, geleë in die afdeling Swellendam, synde die plaas Voorhuis 2, groot 809 morg, Transportakte 9467/1961, gedateer 11 Julie 1961.

Historiese Belang

Hierdie houtskooloond is teen die middel van die 18de eeu deur Hermanus Steyn gebou en is die oudste bekende struktuur in sy soort in Suid-Afrika.
