PROKLAMERING VAN 'N GEDENKWAARDIGHEID.

Kragtens die bevoegdheid my verleen by paragraaf (a) van subartikel (1) van artikel *agt* van die Wet op Natuurlike en Historiese Gedenkwaardighede en Oudhede, 1934 (Wet No. 4 van 1934), soos gewysig, proklameer ek hierby die Herehuis, Tokai, Kaap, as 'n gedenkwaardigheid.

## BESKRYWING.

Die Herehuis, Tokai: Die figuur ABCDEFGH stel voor 1·6895 morg grond synde Lot Manor House en bestaan uit—

- (1) die figuur ABCDEFGponnj wat gedeelte van die Porter Reformatory Estate voorstel (*vide* Kaart No. 5617/1918 aangeheg aan D.G. C.F. 30.6);
- (2) die figuur jkmnopH wat gedeelte van Tokaibosreservaat voorstel (*vide* Plan No. 734 n. G.N. 949/1898), geleë te Tokai in die afdeling Kaap, Provincie Kaap die Goeie Hoop, soos aangedui op Kaart No. 1743/61, gedateer 28 April 1961.

## HISTORIESE BELANG.

Die Herehuis is kort na 1792 deur Jan Andreas Rauch gebou en is een van die beroemdste voorbeelde van die Kaaps-Hollandse boustyl.

PROCLAMATION OF A MONUMENT.

Under and by virtue of the powers vested in me by paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section *eight* of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), as amended, I hereby proclaim to be a monument the Manor House, Tokai, Cape.

## DESCRIPTION.

The Manor House, Tokai: The figure ABCDEFGH represents 1·6895 morgen of land being Lot Manor House and comprises—

- (1) the figure ABCDEFGponnj representing portion of the Porter Reformatory Estate (*vide* Diagram No. 5617/1918 annexed to D.G. C.F. 30.6);
- (2) the figure jkmnopH representing portion of Tokai Forest Reserve (*vide* Plan No. 734 n. G.N. 949/1898), situate at Tokai in the Division of the Cape, Province of the Cape of Good Hope, as shown on Diagram No. 1743/61, dated 28th April, 1961.

## HISTORICAL INTEREST.

The Manor House was built shortly after 1792 by Jan Andreas Rauch and is one of the most famous examples of Cape Dutch architecture.
