Description

The house, known as Stellenberg, surrounded by 15 metres of land and situated on a certain piece of land, being the remainder of Lot Stellenberg, situate in Claremont in the Cape Division (now known as remainder of Erf 63706, Cape Town, at Kenilworth), and measuring as such, 2 morgen 75 057 square feet.

Historical Interest

Stellenberg is one of the finest and most historical of the Cape Dutch gabled houses. It dates from the second half of the eighteenth century.

Beskrywing

Die huis, bekend as Stellenberg, met 15 meter grond daaromheen, geleë op sekere stuk grond, synde die restant van perseel Stellenberg, geleë in Claremont, in die afdeling Kaap (tans bekend as restant Erf 63706, Kaapstad, in Kenilworth), en groot, as sodanig, 2 morg 75 057 vierkante voet.

Historiese Belang

Stellenberg is een van die sierlikste en mees historiese van die Kaaps-Hollandse gewelhuise. Dit dateer uit die tweede helfte van die agtiende eeu.
