BESKRYWING.

Sekere stuk grond, met die Nederduitse Gereformeerde Kerkgebou daarop, naamlik:—

(1) Die Resterende Gedeelte van Erf 524, geleë aan Begemann- en Kerkstraat in die dorp Heidelberg, provinsie Transvaal, groot 228 vierkante roede, 80 vierkante voet kragtens Akte van Transport 3923/1922, gedateer 18 April 1922.

(2) Gedeelte 1 van bogenoemde Erf groot 361 vierkante roede, 76 vierkante voet kragtens Akte van Transport 4827/1897, gedateer 25 Junie 1897.

HISTORIESE BELANG.

Die kerk is in 1890 ingewy. By 'n vergadering in die keldersaal op 24 Julie 1903 gehou, is besluit om 'n volkskool te stig, as gevolg waarvan die huidige Hoër Volksskool en die Heidelbergse Opleidingskollege tot stand gekom het.

'n Historiese gedenkwaardigheidsterrein met die brug, bekend as Meyersbrug daarop, geleë op die plaas Middelburg Town and Townlands 287 JS, provinsie Transvaal, soos aangedui op Kaart L.G. 4604/67, opgemaat in Julie 1967 deur landmeter V. C. Barnes.

HISTORIESE BELANG.

Meyersbrug is een van die mooi klipbrûe wat deur die Suid-Afrikaanse Republiek gebou is. Dit is in 1896 gebou.

BESKRYWING.

Die resterende gedeelte van 'n sekere stuk grond met die geboue daarop, bekend as Die Losie De Goede Hoop, geleë in Kaapstad in die stad Kaapstad, afdeling Kaap (tans bekend as die restant van Erf 95185, Kaapstad

the site on which the Dutch Reformed (N.G.) Church at Heidelberg, Transvaal, stands, with the church building thereon, to be a monument.

DESCRIPTION.

Certain piece of land, with the Dutch Reformed (N.G.) Church building thereon, namely:—

(1) The remainder of Erf 524, situate at Begemann and Church Streets, in the Town of Heidelberg, Province of the Transvaal, 228 square roods in extent, 80 square feet according to Deed of Transfer No. 3923/1922, dated 18 April 1922.

(2) Portion 1 of the above-mentioned Erf 361 square roods, 76 square feet in extent according to Deed of Transfer 4827/1897, dated 25 June 1897.

HISTORICAL INTEREST.

The church was inaugurated in 1890. At a meeting held in the basement hall on 24 July 1903, it was decided to establish a "Volksskool". As a result of this, the present "Hoër Volksskool" and the Heidelberg Training College came into being.

DESCRIPTION.

A historical monument site with the bridge, known as Meyer's Bridge, thereon, situate on the farm Middelburg Town and Townlands 287 JS, Province of the Transvaal, as indicated in Diagram S.G. 4604/67, surveyed by surveyor V. C. Barnes in July 1967.

HISTORICAL INTEREST.

Meyer's Bridge is one of the fine stone bridges built by the South African Republic. It was built in 1896.
