NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT, No. 28 OF 1969

DECLARATION OF THE MAIN BUILDING AND THE HAMILTON HALL SITUATED IN THE GREY COLLEGE COMPLEX AT BLOEMFONTEIN

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 10 (1) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act 28 of 1969), I, Teunis Nicolaas Hendrik Janson, Minister of National Education, hereby declare the Main Building as well as the Hamilton Hall, situated on the Grey College Complex, Bloemfontein, to be a national monument.

Description

The historic Main Building as well as the Hamilton Hall, situated on the Grey College Complex, being certain portion of the Town Commonage of Bloemfontein and measuring 150 morgen.

Deed of Transfer 16475/1906, dated 25 April 1906.

Historical and architectural interest

The corner-stone of the Main Building of the Grey College complex was officially laid by President Reitz on 16 May 1894. The architect was W. H. Stucke.

The Hamilton Hall, designed by Herbert Baker, was officially opened in 1907 by Sir Hamilton Gould-Adams, after whom the hall was named. 10/2/680.

Beskrywing

Die historiese Hoofgebou, asook die Hamiltonsaal, geleë in die Grey Kollege-kompleks, synde sekere gedeelte van die dorpsgronde van Bloemfontein en groot 150 morg.

Transportakte 16475/1906, gedateer 25 April 1906.

Historiese en argitektoniese belang

Die hoeksteen van die Hoofgebou van die Grey Kollege-kompleks is amptelik op 16 Mei 1894 deur president Reitz gelê. Die argitek was W. H. Stucke.

Die Hamiltonsaal, ontwerp deur Herbert Baker, is in 1907 amptelik deur sir Hamilton Gould-Adams, na wie dit vernoem is, geopen. 10/2/680.
