**NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969**

REGISTERING OF WORTHY OF CONSERVATION IMMOVABLE PROPERTY

In terms of section 5 (l) (cC) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act No. 28 of 1969), the National Monuments Council hereby makes an entry in the official register of the immovable property fully described in the Schedule hereto, which the Council regards as worthy of conservation on the ground of its historical, cultural or aesthetic interest.

The facades of the so-called Greenacres building fronting on West Street, as well as the Greenacres passage, in Durban, situated on portions of the following erven:

**NATIONAL MONUMENTS ACT,
No. 28 OF 1969**

PROVISIONAL DECLARATION OF A NATIONAL MONUMENT.—THE BARCLAYS BANK MUSEUM BUILDING, SITUATED AT 90 MARKET STREET, JOHANNESBURG

In terms of section 5 (1) (c) of the National Monuments Act, 1969 (Act No. 28 of 1969), the National Monuments Council hereby provisionally declares the Barclays Bank Museum Building, situated at 90 Market Street, Johannesburg, as described below, to be a national monument.

Description

The Barclays Bank Museum Building, situated on a portion of certain Stand 194 (formerly No. 756), in Market Street, in the Township of Johannesburg, Province of the Transvaal.
