Sekere stuk grond synde Perseel No. 339, bekend as Mapochsgrotte, synde 'n gedeelte van die Mapochs Gronden, geleë in die distrik Middelburg, en groot 73·6809 morg. (Kaart L.G. 1919/34, gedateer 8 November 1934, aangeheg by Kroongrondbrief 4/1937, geregistreer op 7 Januarie 1937.)

HISTORIESE BELANG.

Genoemde gebied bevat waardevolle volkekundige oorblyfsels en het ook 'n belangrike rol in die oorlog teen Niabel in 1882-1883 gespeel.

De Waalpark, Tuine, 'n terrein geleë in die stad en munisipaliteit Kaapstad, administratiewe distrik Kaap, provinsie Kaap die Goeie Hoop, en groot 6·8536 morg, soos aangetoon op Landmeter-generaalkaart 5433/67; 'n ongeregisteerde gedeelte van die eiendom: Sekere stuk grond geleë in die onmiddellike omgewing van die stad Kaapstad, synde gedeelte van die landgoed Oranjezicht (tans bekend as Erf 1227, Oranjezicht) en groot 12 morg 190 vierkante roede (Kaart 1218/1876).

HISTORIESE BELANG.

Die De Waalpark is deur die toedoen van David Christiaan de Waal, L.W.V., Burgemeester van Kaapstad (1889-90) uitgelê en in 1895 as 'n park vir die gebruik van die algemene publiek geopen.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 (1) (a) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), I, Johannes de Klerk, Minister of National Education, hereby proclaim the Mapoch's Caves, Middelburg (Transvaal), to be a monument.

DESCRIPTION.

Certain area of land being Lot No. 339 known as Mapoch's Caves, being a portion of the Mapochs Gronden situate in the District of Middelburg and measuring 73·6809 morgen. (Diagram S.G. 1919/34 dated 8 November 1934 attached to Crown Grant No. 4/1937 registered on 7 January 1937.)

HISTORICAL INTEREST.

The said area contains valuable ethnological relics and also featured prominently in the war against Niabel in 1882-1883.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 (1) (a) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), I, Johannes de Klerk, Minister of National Education, hereby proclaim the De Waal Park, Cape Town, to be a monument.

DESCRIPTION.

De Waal Park, Gardens, an area situate in the City and Municipality of Cape Town, Administrative District of the Cape, Province of the Cape of Good Hope, and measuring 6·8536 morgen, as shown in Surveyor-General Diagram 5433/67; an unregistered portion of the Property: Certain area of land situate in the immediate environs of the City of Cape Town, being part of the Estate of Oranjezicht (now known as Erf 1227, Oranjezicht) and measuring 12 morgen 190 square roods (Diagram 1218/1876).

HISTORICAL INTEREST.

The De Waal Park was laid out through the endeavours of David Christiaan de Waal, M.L.A., Mayor of Cape Town (1889-90) and opened in 1895 as a park for the use of the general public.

Hierdie fort is gedurende die Zoeloe-oorlog van 1879 deur manskappe onder bevel van kol. Pearson gebou.

Die eikebome geleë in—Pastoriestraat; Kerkstraat; Drostdystraat; Van Ryneveldstraat vanaf Dorpstraat tot by Crozierstraat; Andringestraat vanaf Dorpstraat tot by Grozierstraat; Birdstraat vanaf Dorpstraat tot by Crozierstraat; Pleinstraat en Van Riebeeckstraat vanaf Pleinstraat tot by die aansluiting van die Laan, met uitsondering van die noordekant daarvan.

**HISTORIESE BELANG.**

Die dorp Stellenbosch ontleen veel van sy rustige historiese karakter aan hierdie eikebome.

Die hekpile van die plaas Welgelegen, onmiddellik tussen en Oos van die welbekende Windmeule (Mostert's Mill) aan die De Waalpad, geleë op ongeregisteerde terrein van "The Remainder of the place Welgelegen situated in the Cape District at Rondebosch near the Driekoppen (now known as the remainder of Erf 28001 Cape Town at Mowbray)". Kaart 231/1817. Transfer No. 27/1826 (gedateer 14 Julie 1826).

**HISTORIESE BELANG.**

Die oorspronklike hekpile van die oorspronklike plaas Welgelegen word vanweë hulle historiese en estetiese belang

A fort situated on the Fort Kwamondi site on Eshowe Mission Station and remainder of Reserve 17, 7638 situate in the District of Zululand, measuring 3·2443 acres (Diagram S.G. 1102/1967 dated 8 May 1967, surveyed by surveyor I. K. Dunbar in February, 1967.)

**HISTORICAL INTEREST.**

This fort was built during the Zulu War of 1879 by the forces under the command of Col. Pearson.

**PROCLAMATION OF A HISTORICAL MONUMENT.**

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 (1) (a) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), I, Johannes de Klerk, Minister of National Education, hereby proclaim the oak trees in the following streets and portions of streets in the Municipality and District of Stellenbosch, Cape Province to be a monument, viz.:—

**DESCRIPTION.**

The oak trees situate in—Pastorie Street; Church Street; Drostdy Street; Van Rhyneveld Street from Dorp Street to Crozier Street; Andringa Street from Dorp Street to Crozier Street; Bird Street from Dorp Street to Crozier Street; Plein Street and Van Riebeeck Street from Plein Street to the junction of the Avenue, with the exception of the northern side thereof.

**HISTORICAL INTEREST.**

The town of Stellenbosch derives much of its restful, historical character from these oaks.

**PROCLAMATION OF A HISTORICAL MONUMENT.**

By virtue of the powers vested in me by section 8 (1) (a) of the Natural and Historical Monuments, Relics and Antiques Act, 1934 (Act No. 4 of 1934), I, Johannes de Klerk, Minister of National Education, hereby proclaim the gate pillars of Welgelegen, Mowbray to be a monument.

**DESCRIPTION.**

The gate pillars of the farm Welgelegen immediately adjacent to and east of the well-known Windmill (Mostert's Mill), on De Wall Drive, situated on unregistered portion of the remainder of the place Welgelegen situated in the Cape District at Rondebosch near the Driekoppen (now known as the remainder of Erf 28001 Cape Town at Mowbray). Diagram 231/1817. Deed of Transfer 27/1826 (dated 14 July 1826).

**HISTORICAL INTEREST.**

The attractive gate pillars of the original farm Welgelegen are being proclaimed on account of their historical and aesthetic interest.
